To Our Valued Customers:

Adams Produce is **NOT** affected by the voluntary recall of Fresh Express label romaine-based salads. We do not purchase any product from the supplier in question.

The following statement was released on May 24, 2010 by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA):

“Fresh Express is voluntarily recalling a specific selection of Fresh Express Romaine-based ready-to-eat salads with the expired **Use-by Dates of May 13th through May 16th and an "S" in the Product Code** because they have the potential to be contaminated with Salmonella. The recall extends only to products with these Use-by Dates and Product Codes and sold in the following states: Michigan, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Louisiana, Nebraska, Montana, Missouri, Iowa, Kansas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Nevada, Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico, Texas, Oregon, Washington, Alaska, Hawaii, Idaho, Utah, Wyoming, North Dakota, and South Dakota. **No other Fresh Express salads are included in the recall.**”
